主旨：有關紐西蘭增訂Tomato brown rugose fruit virus寄主植物種植用種子緊急輸入檢疫措施，請惠轉知輸出業者配合辦理，請查照。

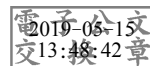
- 一、依據世界貿易組織（WTO）108年3月28日G/SPS/N/NZL/591通知文件（如附件1）辦理。
- 二、旨述緊急措施管制對象為番茄（*Solanum lycopersicum*）及9種番椒屬（*Capsicum annuum*；*C. baccatum*；*C. cardenasii*；*C. chinense*；*C. eximium*；*C. frutescens*；*C. microcarpum*；*C. pendulum*；*C. pubescens*）種子，輸入時應檢附輸出國植物檢疫機關簽發之植物檢疫證明書，依其生產地是否為Tomato brown rugose fruit virus (ToBRFV)之疫區，採不同加註方式：
 - (一)非疫區；
 - (二)非疫生產點，或；
 - (三)來自疫區：依據ISTA (International Seed Testing Association) 或AOSA (Association of Official Seed Analysts) 之取樣方法至少取樣3,000粒種子，並依據國家植物保護機關核可之ELISA方法進行檢測未罹染該病毒。
- 三、經查我國現非ToBRFV之疫區，請貴分局轉知相關輸出業者配合以加註非疫區方式辦理，相關加註內容請參見附件1第6欄。
- 四、次查紐國種植用種子輸入健康標準 (Import Health Standard: Seeds for Sowing)，番茄及番椒屬種子分別另有其他病原應配合加註事項（如附件2），經檢視我國皆為所列病原之



非疫區，可配合以加註非疫區方式辦理。

6. Description of content: The standard describes the import specifications and entry conditions for seeds for sowing imported into New Zealand. Conditions for <i>Tomato brown rugose fruit virus</i> (ToBRFV) The measures are as follows: An additional declaration for 'pest free area' endorsed on the phytosanitary certificate by the NPPO of the exporting country with the following wording: <i>'The (insert seed species) seeds were sourced from pest free area, free from Tomato brown rugose fruit virus'.</i> OR An additional declaration for 'pest free place of production' endorsed on the phytosanitary certificate by the NPPO of the exporting country with the following wording: <i>'The (insert seed species) seeds was sourced from a 'pest free place of production' free from for Tomato brown rugose fruit virus'.</i> OR An additional declaration for testing endorsed on the phytosanitary certificate by the NPPO of the exporting country with the following wording: <i>'The (insert seed species) seed lot was officially tested, on a representative sample of a minimum of 3000 seeds officially drawn according to the ISTA or AOSA sampling methodology, using an approved ELISA NPPO testing method and found free from Tomato brown rugose fruit virus'.</i>

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: There is an unmanaged risk of <i>Tomato brown rugose fruit virus</i> on the <i>Solanum lycopersicum</i> (tomato) and <i>Capsicum</i> sp. (pepper) on the seeds for sowing pathway and it needs to be managed urgently.</p> <p>The amendment is urgent because the risk of introduction and establishment of <i>Tomato brown rugose virus</i> (ToBRFV) via importation of <i>Solanum lycopersicum</i> (tomato) and <i>Capsicum</i> sp. (pepper) seeds for sowing is immediate.</p> <p>There are no specific measures in place for this pathogen on the IHS 155.02.05: Seeds for sowing and tomato and capsicum seeds are actively imported into New Zealand from countries where the pathogen is known to occur.</p> <p>Emergency measures have been implemented under SPS agreement Article 7, annexe B, parts 2 and 6 for the pathogen while a Pest Risk Analysis is completed.</p> <p>The following host species will now require regulation for <i>Tomato brown rugose fruit virus</i>: Tomato and Capsicum.</p> <p>The proposed measures will apply to all countries and are detailed in the <i>Solanum lycopersicum</i> (page 98) and <i>Capsicum</i> (page 30) specific requirements of the seeds for sowing import health standard</p>
